Event Notification

- The NYISO activates the Special Case Resource program and Emergency Demand Response Program for an event or test by:
 - Sending communication from the NYISO to RIPs and CSPs via:
 - Phone
 - Email
 - RIPs and CSPs respond to the notification with expected curtailment values



Event Notification

- Pre-deployment Process:
 - In the Summer 2011 and Winter 2011 2012
 Capability Periods, MPs received communication through
 - Automated phone notification system
 - NYISO e-mail
 - MPs responded to the event via e-mail to the NYISO at: edrp-scr@nyiso.com



Event Notification

- Following the DRIS June 2012 deployment:
 - MPs will continue to receive communication through:
 - Automated phone notification system
 - NYISO e-mail
 - MPs will respond by entering the expected curtailment values for the Event or Test using DRIS

NOTE: Only DRIS users with a <u>DRIS Web UI MP User</u> privilege will have access to respond to the Event or Test



Event Notification Terminology

- Advisory Notification
 - Communication with MPs enrolled in the SCR and EDRP programs to notify them of an anticipated Event
- Activation Notification
 - Communication with MPs enrolled in the SCR and EDRP programs to notify them of an actual Event
- Event
 - The time period when demand response resources reduce load pursuant to NYISO directive



Types of Event Notifications

- Notifications
 - NYISO
 - TDRP
 - Performance Test 1 and Performance Test 2
 - (SCR program only)
- Programs
 - SCR
 - FDRP
- Messages
 - Advisories: Day-Ahead, In-Day
 - Activations: 2-Hour, Immediate
 - Communication Test




Event Notification with DRIS

- DRIS will incorporate Event Notification functionality to:
 - Distribute Notifications to MPs through phone and email
 - Allow MPs to respond in DRIS with curtailment kWs
 - Distribute follow-up reminders to MPs that have not responded to a notification
 - View history of Event and Test Notifications issued by the NYISO
 - View history of MP organization's responses to Event and Test Notifications
 - Allow for periodic Communication Tests of the notification system for new and existing MPs
