Background

- 15-minute intra-hourly scheduling at Chateauguay Interface activated on July 27, 2011
- Update on 15-min scheduling experience at HQ requested by MPs
- Intra-hour ramp initially limited to 25 MW
 - Increased to 50 MW on November 2, 2011
 - Increased to 100 MW on December 1, 2011
 - Expect to increase to 150 MW on February 9, 2012




Analysis

- Period Reviewed: July 27, 2011-January 21, 2012
- Intra-hour schedule adjustments only (:15, :30, :45); top-of-hour adjustments excluded




Average Intra-hour Schedule Change by Intra-hour Block






Average Intra-hourly Schedule Change by Hour of Day






Average Intra-hour Schedule Change by Day






Number of Intra-Hour Schedule Changes Per Day [Max Per Day=72; (3*24)]
