TCC Automation Project Phase 1 Update

- Recall that the TCC automation is moving forward in a series of phases
 - Phase 1 Auction award processing and communications
 - Phase 2 TCC inventory management system
 - Phase 3 Automation of bid and offer entry process

Phase 1 was completed and deployed on June 29th

- Used successfully in production for the August Reconfiguration auction on July 19th
- With the new system in place, email and hardcopy distribution of award notices were discontinued and MPs accessed results directly through the new application

TCC Automation Project Phase 1 Update

- Roll-out of the TCC application went very smoothly
- Attribute this success to a number of "Best Practices"
 - *Rigorous testing, including validation of automated system results against legacy auction results.*
 - *MPs were very involved and active in the Market Trial that paralleled the legacy auction process.*
 - *Provided training, user guide, and "helpful hints" documentation.*
- Did not encounter any significant issues
 - *TCC participants were able to log in, download auction results and make payments.*
- Informal customer feedback has been positive regarding the new system



TCC Automation Project Next Steps

- Shifting focus to Phase 2 work which is already underway
 Potential TCC inventory management system functionality that may be included:
 - Administrative Functions Maintenance of TCC Inventory, Existing Transmission Agreements, Allocation and Reassignment
 - Collateral Off-setting
 - *OPF integration*
 - *Expanded user interface and reporting to support added functionality*
- ✓ Also planning a 1.1 minor release for January
 - ✓ These minor enhancements include:
 - Further automation of several internal processes
 - Explicit MP invoice report
 - User interface navigation enhancements
