

Proposal to Dis-Aggregate Data Posted to the NYISO Web Site for Zones J and K

Background

The Issue:

- BIC passed a motion on September 22, 2000 on Zonal Data Postings.
- LIPA raised concerns with certain zonal data postings, and appealed to the Management Committee on January 9, 2001.
- The MC approved the Appeal, which called for the aggregating the following zonal data for Zones J and K:
 - 1) Zonal Actual loads;
 - 2) Zonal Bid Loads;
 - 3) Zonal Supplier Capacity Forecast Outages, and;
 - 4) Zonal Supplier Actual Capacity

Background

The Issue:

- A request was made at the Public Power/Environmental Sector meeting in March to re-visit this issue.
- Dis-aggregation of Zonal Data was reviewed at the May 10th Joint Scheduling & Pricing/Market Structures Working Groups meeting. No concerns with the proposal to dis-aggregate this data were raised.

Proposal

- Proposal will address currently-posted zonal data—no new data postings are called for in this proposal
- Revised posting of data will not require extensive IT resources; work will be subject to resource availability

Proposal

Motion:

The NYISO Business Issues Committee (BIC) hereby approves the posting of individual zonal load data for all zonal loads in the same manner as outlined in the prior BIC motion that was approved on September 22nd, 2000 and as further presented and discussed at the May 19th, 2004 meeting.

The posting methodology proposed by this motion revises the methodology that was outlined in the Management Committee Appeal dated January 9th, 2001, by directing NYISO staff to disaggregate load data as identified in said motion for Load Zones J and K in future postings.
