MINUTES OF THE MEETING

1. Introduction, Meeting Objectives & Chairman's Report

Mr. Jerry Ancona (National Grid), Chairman, called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

2. Approval of the Minutes

Mr. Ray Stalter (NYISO) presented the minutes from the June 28 meeting. No additional comments were provided.

Motion #1:

Motion to approve the June 28, 2006 meeting Minutes. *Motion passed unanimously by show of hands.*

3. President's Report

Mr. Garry Brown (NYISO) gave the President's Report in place of Mark Lynch, CEO and President. He thanked Ms. Anna Cochrane from the Federal Regulatory Energy Commission for taking the time to spend at the meeting to learn about the New York Market and Market concerns.

Mr. Brown announced that the energy demand record peak was broken on Monday, July 17. The previous record was 32,075MW and the new record hit 32,624MW. The forecast for the 18th also called for another high demand. The SCR/EDRP Program was notified but not called and the participants were put on notice again today.

Mr. Brown reported that, as of early July, the NYISO was on a normal final bill schedule, having caught up on the issuance of final bills. He thanked Mr. Charles Garber (NYISO) and his group for their hard work.

Mr. Brown also noted that a number of wind power projects that sought inclusion in the 2006 class year were approved by the Operating Committee. He also reported that Mr. Lynch testified before Congress as a result of FERC's May report on summer readiness, which identified four potential problem areas in the country – Southern Connecticut, Long Island, New York City Area and Ontario. His complete written testimony is posted on the NYISO website. Regarding price corrections, Mr. Brown noted that reservations and price corrections increased

slightly in June. A project to implement a new enhanced price validation has started.

Speaking to the Joint NYISO Board/MC meeting on Monday, he expressed his thanks to all of the companies that donated prizes for the annual Joint Management Committee / Board outing.

Regarding Market Performance Highlights, Mr. Brown noted the following:

- LBMP prices were up in June compared to May but down since last June.
 Gas prices are helping to lower the LBMP prices.
- Uplift increased fairly significantly in May which is related mostly to a specific set of issues happening on June 1. Mr. Brown gave examples such as simultaneous thunderstorm watch, export considerations, hot weather and a variety of other issues causing high prices in the balancing market with an increase in uplift. He said that this is believed to be an isolated event.

Mr. Tim Bush (representing MEUA) stated his concern regarding the increase in uplift numbers stating that something similar happened last August. He requested that the NYISO investigate. Mr. Brown said that they would do that and would give a full report to the BIC.

Mr. Howard Fromer (PSEG) asked why is there a large deviation between Day Ahead and Real Time prices in the Capital zone. Mr. Brown said he would investigate further.

Mr. Mark Younger (Slater Consulting) requested that sometime in the near future the NYISO do a full analysis of normal peak conditions taking into consideration yesterday and today's load (July 17 -18) since the rest of the forecasting schedule has been shifting up.

Mr. Brown indicated that a review of peak vs. forecasted peak conditions would be undertaken. Ms. Doreen Saia (Mirant) requested that the NYISO give a report on how well the revised load pocket modeling in the Real Time Scheduling System worked during peak conditions. Mr. Brown said they will verify that and bring it back to the next working group meeting.

4. Anna Cochrane (FERC) gave an update on FERC activities. She said that she enjoyed being at this year's meeting, noting that the tone was very upbeat. She said that New York's Market seems to be one that participants are pleased with and that participant's have encouraged the NYISO to promote itself in the industry. She explained the current make-up of the Commission and discussed the role of her office. She reviewed recent activities at the Commission.

5. Recap on Joint Board/MC Meeting

Mr. Brown asked the MPs for opinions on the meeting format. Mr. Ancona said that he would rather see questions without presentations. Mr. Stuart Nachmias (Con

Edison) said he had similar comments but suggested that the format include one panel with representatives from each sector. Mr. Brown said that one limitation was that one person rarely represented the spectrum of the sector.

Mr. Jim D'Andrea (Keyspan) suggested that each representative bring a one page list of topics and present them through two or three panels that would go before the Board. Dr. Kevin Jones (LIPA) wanted it on the record that LIPA is very opposed to sector panels.

Mr. Brown also asked the MPs to think about the location they would like to have next year's meeting.

6. Comprehensive Reliability Plan Update – Carl Patka (NYISO)

Mr. Patka provided an update on the development of the 2005 Comprehensive Reliability Plan (CRP). The Electric System Planning Working Group (ESPWG) and the Transmission Planning Subcommittee (TPAS) have held several meetings reviewing and editing the document. The CRP will be scheduled for review and action by the Operating Committee on July 25, 2006. If the OC recommends that the CRP be approved, the CRP would then be presented to a special meeting of the Management Committee in early August. With the recommendation of the MC, the CRP would then be presented to the NYISO Board later in August for approval.

7. MMU Update

Mr. Scott Maves (NYISO) introduced himself to the MC and gave an overview of the current role of the Market Monitoring Unit within the NYISO. He also detailed the MMP plan for 2007 and listed priority project areas.

Mr. D'Andrea reviewed issues that he also brought up during BIC regarding the impact of mitigation on reliability, including lag times for revisions to reference prices. He also discussed the fluctuating thresholds for mitigation in NYC stating that he didn't think that congestion changed that much within a year. Mr. Maves said that without knowing all the history, he would be hesitant to discuss the topic and said that he would appreciate any of those issues being sent through Market Monitoring. Mr. Maves said that it is important to note that the market is always changing and there is a need to continually look at reference prices to make sure they remain level.

Mr. Matt Picardi (Corel Power) asked if Mr. Maves had reviewed how the NYISO is working with bordering markets, particularly Ontario and how efficient Real Time Trading is working with those markets. Mr. Maves said that this was something that is on the department's agenda.

8.) New Business

Mr. Bush readdressed his concern about uplift and listed two issues – manual adjustments in billing and load ratio share allocation. He said that he would like the MC to charge the BIC to begin a process through one of the working groups to review this

issue to develop whatever tariff changes that are needed in order to properly allocate costs to people who are active in the market. Ray Stalter said he would contact Ray Kinney to add this issue as an action item.

Mr. Neil Butterklee (Con Edison) announced that the By-Laws Subcommittee would meet on July 26 to discuss the OATT liability limitation issue.

9.) Adjournment

The meeting was adjourned 11:45 a.m.
