



Directions

The Sagamore is located on Lake George at 110 Sagamore Road, Bolton Landing, New York 12814. The resort is accessible year round by air to Albany International Airport, by Amtrak from New York and Montreal, and by automobile via Interstate 87 (the Northway). We are within a short drive of most Mid-Atlantic, New England, Quebec and Ontario Province metropolitan areas.

Driving Directions:

NEW YORK CITY TO THE SAGAMORE

From Manhattan, take the George Washington Bridge to New Jersey and proceed to the Palisades Parkway north to the New York State Thruway (I-87). Take I-87 north to Albany, Exit 24. Immediately after the toll booth, take Exit 1N (I-87 North to Montreal).

Continue north on I-87 for 55 miles to Lake George Village - Exit 22 . Stay to the left on the exit ramp and follow signs for Bolton Landing. At the end of the ramp, at the traffic light, turn left onto Route 9N (Lake Shore Drive). Follow road for 9 miles to Bolton Landing. In the Village of Bolton Landing, turn right at the second traffic light onto Sagamore Road. Follow road 1/4 mile over small bridge to the Guest Registration Center on your immediate left after crossing the bridge.

ALTERNATE ROUTE FROM NEW YORK CITY

Take the Major Deegan Expressway to I-87 north and cross the Hudson River via the Tappan Zee Bridge. Proceed north on I-87 (New York State Thruway) to Albany Exit 24 and immediately after the toll booth take Exit 1N (I-87 north to Montreal). Continue to follow directions from second paragraph above.

Distance: 230 miles Time: 4-4 1/2 hours

FROM WESTCHESTER COUNTY TO THE SAGAMORE

Take the Taconic State Parkway north to the end. Take I-90 west to Exit B-1. Follow I-90 west to Exit 1N(I-87 North to Montreal).

Continue north on I-87 for 55 miles to Lake George Village - Exit 22 . Stay to the left on the exit ramp and follow signs for Bolton Landing. At the end of the ramp, at the traffic light, turn left onto Route 9N (Lake Shore Drive).



Transportation: Our Reservation Agents can arrange transportation from three area locations, each within a short car ride to the Resort:

Albany County Airport: 1 hour

Warren County Airport: 30 minutes

Albany Rensselaer Amtrak Station: 1.25 hours

Follow road for 9 miles to Bolton Landing. In the Village of Bolton Landing, turn right at the second traffic light onto Sagamore Road. Follow road 1/4 mile over small bridge to the Guest Registration Center on your immediate left after crossing the bridge.

Distance: 200 miles Time: 3 1/2 hours

FROM BOSTON TO THE SAGAMORE

Take the Massachusetts Turnpike (I-90) West towards Albany. After toll, continue to follow signs for New York State Thruway/I-87. Take NYS Thruway north to Albany Exit 24. Immediately after toll, take Exit 1N (I-87 North to Montreal). Continue north on I-87 to Exit 22, Lake George Village. Stay to the left on the exit ramp and follow signs for Bolton Landing. At the end of the ramp, at the traffic light, turn left onto Route 9N (Lake Shore Drive). Follow road for 9 miles to Bolton Landing. In the village of Bolton Landing, turn right at the second traffic light onto Sagamore Road. Follow road 1/4 mile over small bridge to the Guest Registration Center which is on your immediate left after crossing the bridge.

Distance: 230 miles Time: 4 hours

MONTREAL TO THE SAGAMORE

Take Route 15 south to the border. Take I-87 south to Bolton Landing, Exit 24. At end of ramp turn left and follow road to the end. Turn right onto Route 9N south and follow into the Village of Bolton Landing. Turn left at first traffic light onto Sagamore Road and follow to hotel. The Guest Registration Center is on your left after crossing the bridge.

Distance: 160 miles Time: 3 hours

WESTERN NEW YORK STATE TO THE SAGAMORE

Take the New York State Thruway (I-90) East to Albany exit 24. Go north on the Adirondack Northway (I-87) and get off at exit 22. Take route 9N North for 10 miles to the town of Bolton Landing. At the second traffic light turn right onto Sagamore Road. Follow Sagamore Road onto the Island. The reception building will be on your left after crossing the bridge.

Distance from Buffalo: 360 miles Time: 6 hours
