Dear Ms. Lampi:

On May 21, 2009, New York Independent Systerm Operator, Inc. (NYISO), filed revised tariff sheets<sup>1</sup> to NYISO's Market Administration and Control Area Services Tariff and its Open Access Transmission Tariff to include resources scheduled to provide regulation service among the dispatchable resources evaluated in establishing real-time energy prices. NYISO's submittal is accepted for filing effective July 20, 2009, as requested.

Public notice of NYISO's filing was issued on May 26, 2009, with Interventions and protests due on or before June 11, 2009. recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such acceptance is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against your company.

This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
