Background

- September 13, 2012: NYISO Compliance
 Filing of proposed tariff revisions that will
 enable aggregators or small demand
 response resources to participate in the
 NYISO's Operating Reserves and Regulation
 Services market
- November 1, 2012: Order accepting September filing, with an Effective Date of April 1, 2013
- Revisions made to the Ancillary Services Manual for DSASP Aggregations become effective on April 1, 2013



Enrollment and Registration Process for a DSASP Resource

Enrollment in DRIS

- Individual Demand Side Resource(s) enrolled through the DSASP Enrollment Import into DRIS
- DRIS verifies eligibility and prepares the DSASP Resource Report that is incorporated into the DSASP Resource Registration Packet
 - DSASP Provider completes the remainder of the DSASP Resource Registration Packet and sends to Member Relations

plus <u>Registration in MIS</u>

- NYISO Member Relations confirms DSASP Provider eligibility, including any credit
- Member Relations sends DSASP Resource information to Operations for Modeling
- Member Relations updates MIS with DSASP Resource PTID after it is modeled
- DSASP Provider coordinates with NYISO and the DSASP Resource for the communication and prequalification tests



DRIS Release for DSASP Aggregations

- The DRIS software release to allow enrollment of Demand Side Resources (DSRs) will occur mid-March
- The DSASP Enrollment Import File for DRIS will be available through DRIS and be posted to the NYISO website
- The updated DSASP Resource Registration Packet will be posted to the NYISO website

Registration and Enrollment of an Individual DSR in DSASP Prior to April 1, 2013

- Market Participants may continue to register as a DSASP Provider through the existing process with Member Relations
- Individual DSRs meeting the requirements of the DSASP program may continue to be enrolled through the existing process
- Market Participants with a DSASP Resource(s)
 registered prior to April 1, 2013 will be contacted by
 the NYISO and will be required to re-enroll the DSR
 through DRIS and submit the updated DSASP
 Resource Registration Packet to NYISO Member
 Relations



Registration and Enrollment of an Individual and Group DSRs in DSASP

Beginning April 1, 2013

- Market Participants will continue to register as a DSASP Provider through the existing process with Member Relations
- All Individual and Group DSRs must be enrolled by a DSASP Provider using DRIS prior to registering the DSASP Resource through NYISO Member Relations with the DSASP Resource Registration Packet


