

Operations Scheduler: Multiple Interval

Operations Scheduler Functionality

- Sets ramps for “On-Ramp” units
 - Forward ramp contracts set at this time for 60 minutes into the future
- Decides final CA DNIs
 - Transactions that have changed from DA or now accepted are settled over the period by OS based prices
 - ISO-NE - 1 hour long on fixed on hour interval
 - PJM - 15 minute long periods
- Decides operation of GTs
 - 30 M & 10 M GTs for:
 - economic uses
 - solving security constraints
 - GTs paid based on forward contracts extending 60 minutes into the future
- May not actually need SCD runs in parallel; OS engine may have that functionality

Operations Scheduler: Single Shot

Operations Scheduler Functionality

- Makes last minute security checks for the 15 minute interval starting 5 minutes in the future
- Will set “ignore” flags for constraints that may be momentary/minor in nature
 - Operators may override
- May alter ramps for “On-Ramp” units per business rules and security needs
- May call either 30M or 10 M GTs for security
- Changes settled at RT prices from SCD
