Finalized letter from MTF to BAWG concerning RMR Manual: Duane Wheeler (NYPA) 11/01/2004

The following is a list of items under discussion in the MTF concerning our latest revision of the Revenue Metering Requirements Manual (RMRM) that MTF cannot come to a consensus on. The differences amongst MTF members basically concerns whether or not the manual will be simply a Revenue Metering Requirements Manual or will also include references to processes that support the use of meter based data in the NYISO billing. We will be seeking the direction of BAWG on these issues at their November 9, 2004 meeting.

- 1. Purpose or Objective for the manual.
 - Name of document may be changed or decided on by the manual purpose. I.E. "Revenue Metering" or "Settlement".
 - Do we include in the manual details on daily metering checkout processes?
- 2. Should we include a table or appendix with the definition of NYISO Zones?
- 3. Is it recommended that we include a section on NYISO Billing process as related to metering?
- 4. Should we have a section on the calculation of Subzonal Losses?
- 5. Should there be a section on how external ties and hence inadvertent is handled by NYISO?
- 6. Do we need to describe the use of the Web Based Reconciliation System (WBR)?
- 7. It was thought to include a section on examples of monthly billing schedules specific to the metering data timeline (settlement adjustments or true-ups) for metering and customer load data.
- 8. Describe how WBR and the NYISO PTS data can be used by MA to check out meters.
- 9. Do we need to include in the manual details on the TOL processes from the perspective of the MA and NYISO?
