

**Finalized letter from MTF to CDAS concerning CCR Manual:  
Duane Wheeler (NYPA) 11/02/2004**

The Metering Task Force (MTF) of the Billing and Accounting Working Group is in the process of completing a "Revenue Metering Requirements Manual" (RMRM). It has been discussed within CDAS and MTF that detailed requirements for real-time data should remain in the CCRM avoiding duplication and potential conflicts between the CCRM and the new RMRM. We are seeking the confirmation from CDAS that this position is still valid.

Real-time operational data is critical to timely and accurate NYISO settlements. In our RMRM there is reference to real-time operational metering data used for the NYISO billing processes. This operational generator and tie line MW data gets propagated to the NYISO Performance Tracking System which is then used for NYISO settlement calculations. Our manual references the CCRM as the document defining the details of the real-time metering requirements. Specific to the real-time data that is used in settlements, it is the desire of MTF to allow CDAS to review and comment on our draft of the RMRM before finalizing the document as well as be allowed to review and comment to CDAS on the CCRM.
