

Summary of Emergency Curtailment Program Discussion Points
Nov. 28, 2000 PRLWG meeting

1. Curtailment Service Providers:

- LSE
- Aggregators
- Direct customer
- Curtailment program customer

Substance

- Definition of curtailment customer
- Inclusion of aggregators?

Details

- 100 kW within a zone
- curtailment customer pays for admin, metering, etc.
- who is responsible for metering, validation?

2. Effective May 1 - end 2002. Program will be evaluated after each capability period

Substance

- End date: Oct. 31, 2002
- Participation will be impacted by termination date

Details

- Signup, dropout rules
- Notify ISO of all resources participating
- What constitutes an evaluation?

3. Voluntary - no penalties for non-performance

No changes

4. Existing LSE programs qualify - no double-counting

Substance

- Cannot have more than one entity subscribe same metered load for ISO program
- Customer should get paid higher of two possible payments (ISO, LSE)

Details

- ISO and LSE agree on program compatibility

5. Initial settlement based upon ISO-LSE meter data reporting requirements

Removed from list.

6. Record performance via hourly interval metering

Substance

- Change to "curtailment service provider"
- curtailment customer pays for admin, metering, etc.

Details

- metering configuration (load + gen)

7. Load reduction verified by NYISO through data submitted by CSP within 45 days

Substance

- determine default verification process

8. Limited to Major Emergencies - called with Special Case Resources

Substance

- need more exact definition of when ECP is called (DEC concern)

Details

- 2-hour notice - discuss with Operations personnel

9. CSP will designate contact person and will be responsible for communicating w/load reduction customers

No changes

10. Payment: greater of real-time zonal LBMP or \$500/Mwhr

Substance

- 4-hour minimum participation payment
- get higher of LBMP or \$500 for max(2 hrs, duration of outage); LBMP thereafter

11. Minimum 100 kW response; 2-hour response time

Substance

- must respond within two hours
- payment clock starts when customer responds

12. Participate for minimum 10 hours cumulatively over program operating period

Remove from list.

13. Customers under contract limiting energy curtailment cannot participate

No changes

14. Costs allocated on system-wide basis

Substance

- if program is activated by NYISO to respond to a zonal emergency the fund will be charged to all LSEs in the zone.
- Alternative position - costs allocated based upon resource adequacy

15. LSE-initiated requests to invoke program must be approved by NYISO to qualify for payments

16. ECP customers may also serve as Special Case Resources
