Market Services 2003 Proposed Staff Additions

- Total Market Services proposed staff increase of 17* (9/30 proposal called for 21 additions)
- Changes from 9/30 BSP presentation result in 4 staff positions deferred to 2004 (3: Market Monitoring, 1: Committee Support)

*Includes 3 contractors

- Full Tariff and Market Monitoring Plan Compliance
 - Performance Tracking Requirement Met
 - Comprehensive Mitigation Order Requirements Met
 - Internal Audit Recommendations Achieved

Major Benefits

- Customer/Stakeholder Support
 - FERC Office of Market Oversight & Investigation
 - NY PSC and other regulatory entities (GA, DOE, NY AG)
 - Maintain existing level of MP customer support while customer base increases
 - Improved Market Analysis
 - Monitoring of NYISO Operations Impact on Market Prices
 - TCC Auction Process/Outcome
 - ICAP Auction Process/Outcome
