Cayuga Unit 2

Dear Secretary Burgess:

Cayuga Operating Company, LLC (“Cayuga Operating Company”) hereby provides notice that the New York Independent System Operator, Inc. (“NYISO”) will place its Cayuga Unit 2, a 167.2 (nameplate) coal-fired generating unit (“Cayuga 2”), into an ICAP Ineligible Forced Outage beginning on July 1, 2018. Pursuant to Cayuga Operating Company’s Title V air permit, Cayuga 2 must cease operation until it installs a selective catalytic reduction system to reduce nitrogen oxide emissions or refuels the unit with natural gas.

Cayuga Operating Company is pursuing a refueling of Cayuga 2 pursuant to its Title V air permit requirements. Beginning July 1, 2018, Cayuga 2 will not be able to operate until modifications are made to its boiler to convert it to burn 100% natural gas.

Cayuga Operating Company contemporaneously has sent a copy of this notice to the NYISO via e-mail directed to its designated address and to New York State Electric & Gas Corporation, the utility to which Cayuga 2 is interconnected and in whose service territory the unit is located.
