RE: Notice of Retirement of Hudson Avenue GT#4; PTID # 23540; Name Plate
Rating: 16.3 MW

Dear Ms. Burgess:

Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (“Con Edison”) hereby provides notice to the New York State Public Service Commission (“NYPSC”), that it intends to retire Hudson Avenue Gas Turbine #4 (“GT #4”) as soon as practicable. Con Edison intends to retire GT #4 after the New York Independent System Operator, Inc. (“NYISO”) completes the Generator Deactivation Assessment (“GDA”) but not sooner than August 25, 2019. On April 1, 2019, the NYISO started the GDA in order to ascertain whether a Generator Deactivation Reliability Need (“GDRN”) will result from GT#4 becoming retired. A GDRN is a condition identified by the NYISO in a GDA as a violation or potential violation of one or more Reliability Criteria. The NYISO’s due date for the completion of the GDA is June 30, 2019.

GT #4 began operations on July 1, 1970. GT#4 has been operated to provide electric energy and has not been a supply source for the Con Edison steam system. On September 15, 2018, GT #4 was taken out of service because the gas turbine needed to be repaired. Subsequently, Con Edison determined that it was not economic to repair GT # 4, given the estimated repair cost. Moreover, new

environmental regulations that will become effective in 2020 would also require substantial investment in GT #4, which would make it even more uneconomic to repair.
