RE: Notice of Deactivation of the Auburn State Street Gas Turbine (PTID #24147), Nameplate Rating: 7.4 MW

Dear Secretary Burgess and Ms. Davies,

On April 8, 2019 New York State Electric & Gas Corporation ("NYSEG") notified the New York State Public Service Commission ("NYSPSC") and New York Independent System Operator, Inc. ("NYISO") that it intended to discontinue operations of the Auburn State Street Gas Turbine ("State St. GT"). On May 10, 2019, NYISO deemed the Deactivation Notice of the State St. GT to be complete.

On August 1, 2019, NYISO completed the Generator Deactivation Assessment ("Assessment") for the State St. GT. This Assessment did not identify a reliability need following the deactivation of the State St. GT for the study period and stated that NYSEG could deactivate the State St. GT on or after August 9, 2019.

This letter provides formal notice to the NYSPSC and NYISO that NYSEG will cease operations of the State St. GT on October 1, 2019.
