## MOTION OF THE NEW YORK INDEPENDENT SYSTEM OPERATOR, INC. FOR LEAVE TO ACCEPT COMPLIANCE FILING ONE DAY OUT OF TIME

Pursuant to Rule 212 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure,<sup>1</sup> the New York Independent System Operator, Inc. ("NYISO") hereby seeks leave of the Commission to accept one day out of time its electronically-submitted compliance filing pursuant to the Commission's May 20, 2003, Order ("May 20 Order") in the above-captioned proceeding.<sup>2</sup>

The Commission's September 22 Order, which approved proposed tariff amendments to implement Demand Curves in the NYISO Installed Capacity ("ICAP") markets, also directed the NYISO to make a compliance filing on December 1, 2003 and annually for two years thereafter that reports on the implementation of the ICAP Demand Curves and a compliance filing on that same date and continuing annually thereafter that evaluates any withholding behavior that may have occurred in the ICAP markets.

The NYISO's second annual compliance report on the implementation of the ICAP Demand Curves and the NYISO's evaluation of any withholding behavior in the ICAP markets was due on December 1, 2004. Due to technical difficulties in attempting to electronically submit this compliance report, the NYISO did not complete the submission until 5:58 p.m. on

December 1, 2004. As a result, the electronic Notice of Acknowledgement received by the NYISO from the Commission's Office of the Secretary indicates a filing date of December 2, 2004. The NYISO, therefore, respectfully requests that electronically-submitted compliance filing described above be accepted one day out of time.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, the New York Independent System Operator, Inc. respectfully requests that the Commission grant its request that the NYISO's electronically-submitted compliance filing in the above referenced docket be accepted one day out of time.
