Proposal to Establish New Sub-Sector within the Public Power/Environmental Parties Sector for Distributed Generators and Demand Response Providers

This proposal would establish a new sub-sector within the Public

Power/Environmental Parties Sector for parties who qualify as Distributed Generators or

Demand Response Providers. Two (2) percent of the total votes on the Management

Committee shall be allocated to this new sub-sector.

The 2 percent allocation would come from equal four-tenths (0.4) percent reductions from each of the five existing Sectors, with the proviso that neither the Environmental Parties sub-sector, nor any Governmental Agency sub-sector (whether representative or consuming) shall have their current voting allocation reduced.

The proposed change would result in the following voting weight allocations:
