Energy Spectrum is has been a Responsible Interface Party (RIP) involved with the NYISO for over five years Pursuant to the Procedural Rules for Appeals to the ISO Board on March 10, 2011, the New York State Consumer Protection Board ("CPB") appealed to the Board the Management Committee's vote at its February 24, 2011 meeting that failed to pass the CPB's motion to amend the NYISO's tariffs to provide a structure and funding mechanism for an End Use Consumer Sector Consultant. Energy Spectrum fully supports the CPB's appeal of the February 24, 2011 MC decision. Effective representation of all NYISO customers is essential for NYISO governance. End Users are important for the NYISO as they ultimately pay all electric costs. Yet consumers do not have the resources to participate effectively in the myriad of issues and venues that arise at the NYISO. Other sectors have the expertise and resources to effectively monopolize NYISO governance. Those other parties' interests are not consistent with end use customers. The MC secret ballot to deny funding was ill-advised and ill-timed.

We urge the Board to act on the Appeal by reversing the decision of the MC.
