Proposed letter from MTF to CDAS concerning RMR Manual: Drafted by Duane Wheeler (NYPA) 10/27/2004

The Metering Task Force (MTF) of the Billing and Accounting Working Group is in the process of completing a "Revenue Metering Requirements Manual" (RMRM). It has been discussed within CDAS and MTF that detailed requirements for Real Time data should remain in the CCRM Manual avoiding duplication and potential conflicts between the CRRM manual and the new RMRM manual. We are seeking confirmation from CDAS that this position is still valid.

Real-time operational data is critical to timely and accurate NYISO settlements. In our RMRM there is reference to real-time operational metering data used for the NYISO billing processes. The manual references the CRRM as a document for the reader to view the details of Real Time Metering requirements. The real-time operational and tie line MW data propagates to the NYISO Performance Tracking System that is used in the calculations at the Security Constraint Dispatch (SCD) level for NYISO settlements. It is the desire of MTF to allow CDAS to review and comment on a draft of the RMRM before finalizing the document as well as be allowed to review and comment on the CCRM concerning the real-time data that is used in settlements.
