Attendance at Oral Argument Before NYISO Board
Regarding New ICAP Demand Curves
For 2011/2012, 2012/2013 and 2013/2014 Capability Years

As previously announced, the Reliability and Markets Committee of the NYISO Board of Directors will entertain oral arguments on October 18, 2010, concerning the proposed new Installed Capacity (“ICAP”) Demand Curves from those stakeholders who have submitted written comments and have requested the opportunity to appear before the Board. Oral arguments will take place in the offices of Hunton & Williams, 200 Park Avenue, 52nd Floor, New York, NY.

The Board has scheduled a 90 minute period to hear the oral arguments. Oral argument is anticipated to begin by 3:30 p.m. promptly upon the conclusion of other Board agenda items. Accordingly, oral argument participants should plan to arrive no later than 3:00 p.m. The time allotted will be split equally between those stakeholders seeking adjustments that would result in increasing the ICAP Demand Curves above the NYISO’s proposal, and those stakeholders seeking adjustments that would result in maintaining or lowering the Curves from the proposal. Stakeholders within each of these two groups should caucus among themselves to decide the order in which they wish to appear and the use of their respective time allotment.

Attendance at the meeting of the Reliability and Markets Committee will be limited to those stakeholders who have submitted written comments and have requested the opportunity to appear before the Board (“appellants”). Because of the size of the room, the NYISO requests that only one representative per appellant appear for the oral argument.
