Performance Measurements

- ◆ For aggregations that are awarded less than their total registered value in any month:
 - *All resources registered in the aggregation are expected to perform at their registered levels during an audit. Non-performance of resources during an audit will count toward their individual performance factors and the RIP Portfolio Performance Factor.*
 - *For an event during the month, NYISO expects all resources registered in an aggregation that sold less than its offered Megawatts to perform at the proportional rate of what was sold.*
- ◆ Non-performance during an audit of resources that were not a part of an aggregation and have not been offered at all during a Capability Period will not count toward individual performance factors or RIP Portfolio Performance Factors.

Performance Measurements

- ◆ Resources unavailable during an audit due to a scheduled outage whose RIP has 1) notified the NYISO prior to the outage and 2) not sold the resource for the period covered by the outage will not have the outage count toward individual performance factors or RIP Portfolio Performance Factors.
- ◆ In the past, the NYISO has used the declared load reduction value from the month an audit is conducted. Beginning with Summer 2008 Capability Period, NYISO will compare performance during an audit with the average of the declared load reduction values for the capability period.
