- Sept. 4, 2001 FERC order accepting Services Tariff revisions regarding implementation of a Unforced Capacity methodology, reduction of the Obligation Procurement Period to one month and directing the NYISO to file a revenue neutral translation calculation of the in-city price cap into UCAP terms (ER01-2536-000)
- Sept. 4, 2001 FERC order approving PJM tariff revisions for a Interregional Transmission Pilot Program for generation redispatch in PJM and New York (ER01-2528-000)
- Sept. 5, 2001 FERC notice granting an extension of time until September 14, 2001 to make a compliance filing regarding Transmission Service Charge information (ER01-2230-000)
- Sept. 10, 2001 FERC administrative order granting rehearing for further consideration of its July 12, 2001 order concerning the NYISO's RTO filing (RT01-95-001)
- Sept. 13, 2001 FERC letter order accepting the NYISO's compliance filing and the description of the cost allocation methodology for the Incentivized Day-Ahead Economic Load Curtailment Program (ER01-1740-002)
- Sept. 14, 2001 FERC letter order accepting the NYISO's Services Tariff compliance filing regarding revised recall procedures (ER00-3740-001)
- Sept. 17, 2001 FERC order granting the ISONE and NECPUC requests for clarification and denying the NYISO's request for hearing regarding the July 25, 2001 order dismissing as moot the Standard Market Design document submitted by ISONE and NEPOOL (RT01-99-002, ER01-2115-002)
- Sept. 19, 2001 FERC notice granting the NYISO a second extension of time until September 21, 2001 to make a compliance filing regarding Transmission Service Charge information (ER01-2230-000)
- Sept. 24, 2001 FERC notice granting the NYISO an extension of time until October 8, 2001 to respond to an amended third party complaint regarding the provision of station service power (EL01-50-000)
- Sept. 26, 2001 FERC order denying in part and granting in part the NYISO's request for rehearing of certain RTO related issues contained in the FERC's July 27, 2001 order regarding the Neptune Regional Transmission System (ER01-2099-001)
- Sept. 26, 2001 FERC order denying multiple third party requests for stay of the FERC's July 20, 2001 order granting rehearing of its May 16, 2001 order rejecting the revised market power mitigation measures proposed by Consolidated Edison (EL01-45-004, ER01-1385-002)
