- The RNA is a worst case scenario that paints a very conservative view of the system - by design - which does not include known plans by developers. Is there a way the RNA can be presented such that it is viewed in the proper perspective?
- Believe we should revisit the issue of a 5 year demarcation for the submittal of detailed vs. theoretical backstop project designation.
