Background

- MPs in TPAS have been working through several interconnection-related issues
- Amendments under discussion relate to the administration of the system upgrade cost allocation process
- Today's proposals address the obligations of the NYISO, developers, and the TOs following completion of the cost allocation studies for a given Class Year
- These changes will govern the Catch Up Class
- OC approved tariff language on June 9th—
unanimously, with abstentions

Summary of Proposed Tariff Revisions

- **Project Re-Entry (Attachment S)**
 - *Establishes rule for mandatory re-entry into the Class Year cost allocation process*
 - *OC Modification to TPAS language*
 - ▶ Moved re-entry point to start of project construction
- **Headroom Accounting (Attachment S)**
 - *Clarifies headroom accounting procedures to reflect the impact of subsequent projects*
 - *Consistent with the Keyspan Settlement*
 - **No OC Modification**

Proposed Tariff Revisions (Cont'd)

- **Project Cost & Status Tracking (Attachment X)**
 - *Requires developers and TOs to report on status of construction activities for the interconnection facilities required by the Class Year Facilities Study*
 - *Requires TOs to report on costs and deviations from prior estimates*
 - *Purpose is to provide greater transparency*
 - **OC Modification:**
 - ▶ Reporting requirement changed from monthly to bi-monthly
