SMD2 Software Assessment

- > NYISO staff continues to closely monitor performance of new SMD2 software
- Given unexpected issues with real-time software, the NYISO is cautious about making additional changes before Summer
- New enhancements will be deployed only after rigorous testing and post-deployment review of previous enhancements.



May Software Release

- > Contents: Software to implement Controllable Tie Lines and certain SMD2 enhancements
- Software deployed successfully on May 31 following 3 months of testing
- Manageable number of follow-up issues were corrected during the following week
- Post-deployment review of software and performance is ongoing



June Software Release

- Contents: E-Tagging improvements, Facilitated Checkout enhancements, and DSS features
- > Integration testing has been ongoing since mid-May; no significant barriers to implementation
- Deployment scheduled for final week in June
 - Actual date to be determined by conditions



July Software Release

- Contents: GT Scheduling in RTD and certain additional SMD2 enhancements
- > Testing started in early June and has been proceeding well; integration testing by QA set to begin week in late June
- > Deployment tentatively scheduled for mid-July
 - Actual date to be determined by conditions
- > Implementation of the GT Scheduling in RTD software is dependent on regulatory approval



September Software Release

- > Contents: UCAP Auction Automation, additional billing automation deliverables, and DSS enhancements
 - Actual deliverables for September will be finalized following detailed release planning
- > Deployment tentatively scheduled for late September
 - Actual date to be determined by schedule and conditions
- Implementation 15-Minute Scheduling may be bundled with September release, or deployed earlier as conditions permit
