# **BAS** Database Upgrade

- The Billing and Accounting System (BAS)
   database is currently scheduled for an outage
   from <u>4pm</u>, <u>Friday May 21<sup>st</sup></u> to Monday 8am
- The outage is needed to migrate to new hardware and to upgrade to Oracle 11g in order to maintain performance and system support



# **BAS** Database Upgrade

- Daily Advisories will not be produced during the outage
- Market Participants will be unable to upload or download via SDX during the outage, e.g.:
  - Generator and Tie data
  - Minimum Oil Burn event data
- SDX will be available for upload/download between 8am - 12pm Monday, May 24<sup>th</sup>
- The advisory process will begin Monday afternoon, starting with Friday's bill




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- A timeline will be supplied in early May via an email to the Tie List and BAWG Distribution List
