Revisions

- Section 3.4 Establishing an LSE's Minimum Unforced Capacity Requirement for an Obligation Procurement Period
 - Updated to reflect that calculations of Minimum Unforced Capacity Requirements are subject to revisions to account for Locality Exchange MW

- Section 3.6.1 Minimum Unforced Capacity Requirements for Transmission Districts in a Locality
 - Updated to include calculations for minimum Unforced Capacity Requirements for a Locality and to include calculations for Locality Exchange MW
 - Updated language

- Section 3.6.2 Minimum Unforced Capacity Requirements for LSEs Serving Loads in a Locality
 - Updated language and to reflect location of Locality Exchange MW

- Section 4.9.5 Exports External Sales of NYCA Installed Capacity
 - Updated to reflect notification obligations of Generators located in Import Constrained Localities in order to export capacity
 - Notification sent to <u>ICAP_info@nyiso.com</u> with the following information:
 - Name and PTID of Generator
 - Month and year of export
 - MW amount of ICAP to be exported
 - Control Area receiving Export
 - Updated to reflect that capacity from Import Constrained Localities will not be eligible to be exported if notification obligations are not followed

- Section 4.9.5 Exports External Sales of NYCA Installed Capacity
 - The version presented today corrects two additional errors to the version posted as Manual Under Review
 - Insertion of a comma: "Additionally, in order for a Generator located in an Import Constrained Locality to be eligible to export capacity to an External Control Area, the"
 - Insertion of "be": "Capacity from a Generator will not be eligible to be exported if"

Revisions to Version Presented at March 8 ICAPWG Meeting

- Based on stakeholder input, the following incremental revisions are proposed
 - Section 3.6.1, updated for connsistently in several places as follows: "minimum Unforced Capacity Requirements"
 - Corrected a typographical error as follows: "The Locational Minimum Unforced Capacity Requirement for LSEs in an Import Constrained Locality will be based on the removal of Locality Exchange MW."
 - Removed the following language because redundant in the context of the formula: "ICL_L = the Localities located within Import Constrained Locality L which the Generator(s) with Locational Export Capacity MW is electrically located"
