ISO tie list announcement

The New England to New York transfer capability is expected to be limited from approximately September 8 to November 1, 2004 as a result of outages at the Todd Road 115kV transmission facility in Southwest Connecticut. Transfers from New England to New York will be restricted because of potential limitations associated with the 115kV transmission system in Southwest Connecticut.

As a result of the expected restrictions, and based on an ISO review of anticipated system conditions, the NYISO will limit the New England to New York Total Transfer Capability (TTC) to 400MW for the Day-Ahead Markets during the outages of the Todd Road 115kV transmission facility. The corresponding Hour-Ahead and Real-Time Market TTC values may be adjusted higher or lower as in-day system conditions permit.

The New York to New England TTC will remain unchanged at 1000MW during the Southington-Todd Road 115kV transmission facility outage period.

Summary

- NE->NY transfer capability limited from September 8 to November 1, 2004
- NE->NY DAM TTC limited to 400MW from normal limit of 1200MW
- NE->NY RTM TTC limited to 400MW. TTC values may be adjusted higher or lower as in-day system conditions permit.
- NY->NE transfer capability TTC will remain unchanged at 1000MW
