New York's Clean Energy Standard (CES) calls for 50% of the state's electricity to be produced from renewable resources by 2030, roughly doubling the amount of renewable energy produced in New York in the next fourteen years. Such a rapid expansion of renewable resources will create wide ranging changes for NYISO's markets, operations, and planning efforts. Discussions are intended to provide an overview of efforts to promote renewable energy around the nation, experiences and challenges seen in integrating renewable resources at larger penetration levels, and regional implications associated with one state establishing such aggressive goals relative to neighboring states. At the same time, utilities are adapting their business models in the face of sweeping changes stemming from public policy initiatives such as the CES and REV. Con Edison will offer insight into its effort to reshape itself as the Utility of the Future and what this means for the way it operates and plans its system.
