# Agenda

- **Review updates to Section 18.1.1 (Table 1A) of Attachment L of the Open Access Transmission Tariff (OATT) related to a recently processed Accepted Revision**
  - **The Accepted Revision process is set forth in Section 17.9.3 of Attachment K to the OATT and is intended to ensure the ongoing accuracy of the information contained in Table 1A**
- **The NYISO customarily provides an initial overview of Accepted Revisions at a MIWG meeting after posting notice thereof to the market**

# Accepted Revision Overview

- Affected Table 1A Contracts are 189.1 and 190.1
- Contract expiration/termination dates revised from “12/31/2017” to “12/31/2027”
  - Effective August 14, 2017
  - Request by the New York Power Authority (NYPA) to amend the underlying agreements to extend the original termination dates listed in Table 1A

# Accepted Revision Overview (continued)

- Footnotes (6) and (7) of Table 1A are also being revised as follows in connection with the Accepted Revision:
  - (6) - Subject to NYPA's obtaining non-discriminatory long term firm reservation through ~~2017~~ 2027 under its OATT.
  - (7) - **For Contract # 189.1 and 190.1, NYPA's TCCs allocated to its SENY Governmental Load Customers will terminate on the earlier of December 31, 2027 or when NYPA no longer has an obligation to serve any of the SENY Governmental Load Customers; provided, however, that the term may be extended beyond December 31, 2027 if NYPA continues to have an obligation to serve any of the SENY Governmental Load Customers. For Contract # 189.2 and 190.2, NYPA's TCCs allocated to its SENY Governmental Load Customers will terminate on the earlier of December 31, 2017 or when NYPA no longer has an obligation to serve any of the SENY Loads or the retirement or sale of both IP#3 and Poletti.**

# Next Steps

- Proceed through normal stakeholder process at a later date to pursue approval of tariff revisions to incorporate the Accepted Revision into the OATT
  - The standard practice is to pursue such tariff updates on an annual basis utilizing 12-month periods encompassing June 1<sup>st</sup> through May 31<sup>st</sup> of the following year
