Prerequisites to View DSASP Enrollments

- Prior to viewing DSASP Resources in DRIS,
 Market Participants must have completed the following:
 - Successfully imported Demand Side Resources (DSRs) into DRIS for DSASP




From the DSASP Menu select Enrollment Details



- Enrollment details are viewable on the DSASP Enrollment Screen
- An enrollment record will be displayed for a DSASP resource each time the resource has received a new Enrollment Status








- Search Criteria
 - MP Name
 - Resource ID
 - Zone
 - Aggregation
 - Gen PTID
 - From/To Dates

- Status
 - Active Record Default
 - Displays most recent enrollment record with no End Effective Date for one of the following Enrollment Statuses
 - Qualified
 - Submitted
 - Validated
 - Separated







Example:

- Resource ID 203700 was successfully imported, creating a record with a Validated Enrollment Status
- Resource ID 203700 has an Enrollment Status of Submitted with an End Effective Date, which indicates the resource was either selected in the submission of Aggregation 1027 and that the aggregation became Qualified (Similarly possible when the submission is canceled)
- Resource ID 203700 has an Enrollment Status of Qualified with a Null End Effective Date, which indicates the resource is currently participating as part of a DSASP Resource in the Ancillary Services Market
- If another submission of Aggregation 1027 occurs and Resource ID 203700 is selected to remain in the Qualified Aggregation, the resource would have an additional record with an Enrollment Status of Submitted with no End Effective Date

Separating a DSR from MP Portfolio



Separating a DSR from MP Portfolio

Validated

 When the only resource record with no End Effective Date is a Validated record, the resource can be immediately Separated from an aggregation

Submitted


- A Submitted record exists with no End Effective Date
- A resource cannot be Separated when it is part of an active Submittal

Qualified

- A Qualified record exists with no End Effective Date
- A resource cannot be Separated when it is part of a Qualified Aggregation
- The resource must be removed from active participation in the Qualified Aggregation through the Submittal process, before separating




Separating a resource





- Separating a resource Validated
 - Choose a resource which has only a Validated Enrollment record with a null end effective date



Confirm separation

 Successfully separating a resource will end-date the Validated Enrollment record



 Successfully separating a resource will begin-date a resource Enrollment record of Separated






Separating a resource - Qualified


 Choose a resource which has a Qualified Enrollment record with a null end effective date

Exception error will display






DSASP Resource Enrollment Information on the Capability Period Enrollments Screen

 From the Resource Menu select Capability Period Enrollments





 - When the resource is enrolled in an economic and reliability program with the same MP







 - Program Capability Details will remain blank unless also enrolled in SCR or EDRP with same MP, in Capability Period defined in search criteria





DSASP Enrollment Statuses

Status	Begin Effective Date (when the record is created)	End Effective Date
Validated	A new Validated record is created when: • The resource is initially imported successfully into DRIS • Each time an update to the resource is imported successfully into DRIS	The Validated record remains active until: • An update is imported into DRIS which creates a new Validated record • The resource is Separated from the Market Participant portfolio
Submitted	A new Submitted record is created when: • The resource is included in the submission of the Aggregation to either become or remain part of the Qualified Aggregation • The resource is currently part of the Qualified Aggregation and is being submitted for removal from the Qualified Aggregation (this does not remove the resource from a Validated Status in the aggregation)	The Submitted record remains active until: • The Submitted Aggregation becomes Qualified • The submission of the aggregation is Canceled

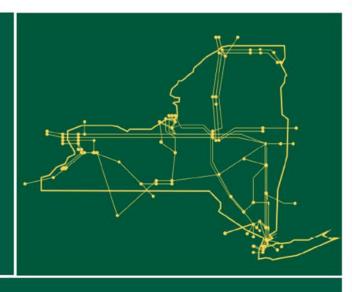


DSASP Enrollment Statuses

Status	Begin Effective Date (when the record is created)	End Effective Date			
Qualified	A new Qualified record is created when: • The Submitted Aggregation becomes Qualified and the resource was submitted to either become or remain part of the Qualified Aggregation	The Qualified record remains active until: • The resource was submitted on a subsequent Submission of the Aggregation to remain part of the Qualified Aggregation and a new Qualified record has been created for the resource based on the new Submission of the Aggregation becoming Qualified • The resource was submitted on a subsequent Submission of the Aggregation to be removed from the aggregation and the new Submission of the Aggregation becoming Qualified • The resource is Separated from the MP portfolio			
Separated	A new Separated record is created when: • The resource is Separated from the MP portfolio	The Separated record remains active until:The resource is re-enrolled with the MP in DSASP
