



E-Tagging Project Summary

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E-Tag Project Objectives

- Ensure that E-Tag data accurately reflects NYISO bids and schedules.
- Reduce MP administrative burden when scheduling transactions across control areas.
- Improve coordination with neighbors.
- Promote compliance with NERC Policy.

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Seams Issues Addressed

Participants will benefit from the following:

- **Accurate and meaningful response to E-Tag requests from NYISO**
 - *No longer exclusively “Passive Approval”*
- **No longer required to update E-Tag to reflect NYISO schedules**
 - *Will be done automatically and more timely*
- **Consistent NERC-compliant E-Tag adherence among all regional CA’s**



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Approve E-Tag Business Process

- **E-Tags received from the market will be validated against MIS bids and schedules**
 - *Energy profiles from MIS bids with matching E-Tag IDs will be compared; time and energy*
- **MPs and other Control Areas get more visibility into the status of NYISO E-Tags received.**



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Adjust E-Tag Business Process

- **NYISO adjustments to scheduled MWs will automatically change the corresponding E-Tag to provide the best info on what will flow in RT. Adjustments may occur;**
 - *After a HAM posting*
 - *After Checkout*
 - *After any subsequent curtailment*
 - *Any HAM schedule change made during DAM checkout/rollover*
