[Attachment P](#) **Examples of Transmission Capability-Related Improvements That Will Not
Be Considered for Incremental TCC Awards**
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The following table provides an Expander with a list of improvements that the NYISO will not allow Incremental TCC awards. The table is organized by type of Expansion and an explanation of why it is ineligible for an Incremental TCC award.

Expansion or Expansion Characteristics	Reason for Exclusion from an Award of Incremental TCCs
Any change that cannot be modeled in the NYISO's Day-Ahead Market (DAM) with reasonable certainty.	This would include but not be limited to situations such as dynamic line ratings (available only for Real-Time) or increased transfer that is dependent on certain generator(s) to be committed.
Generation addition or SPS requiring generation to be in-service.	The status of generating units is dependent on their economic bids which may or may not result in their being scheduled in the DAM. TCCs that may otherwise be created when a generator is in-service would not be present when the generator is out of service.
Controlled line over an External Interface	These situations require Proxy Bus modeling and bids at their respective terminals. Congestion in the NY as well as neighboring areas is incorporated into the prices at the respective Proxy Generator Bus. The rights to service over such facilities are addressed by mechanisms outside of the NYISO Tariff.
