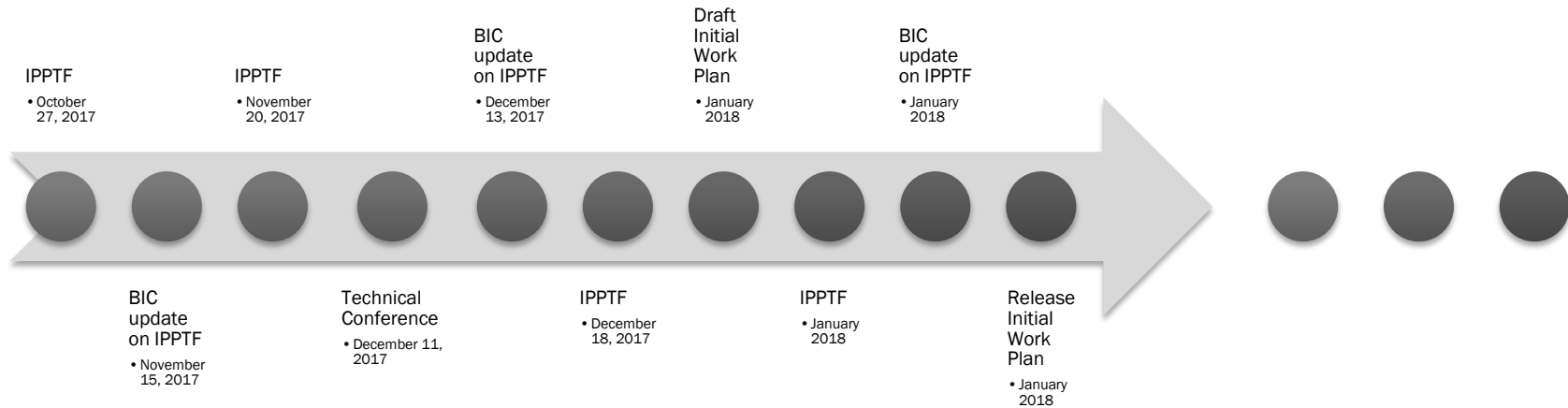
Harmonizing Public Policy - IPPTF

■ Purpose of the task force

- Facilitate a stakeholder dialogue on carbon pricing concepts and other market design alternatives to harmonize NYISO-administered wholesale electricity markets and state energy policies.
- Enhance understanding of carbon pricing concepts, identify issues that need further examination, and assess potential impacts of various approaches to harmonizing markets and public policy.
- Contribute to the NYISO/New York State team's development of a work plan by the end of January 2018. The work plan is intended to lead to a proposal for stakeholder consideration to harmonize NYISO markets and New York State policy on carbon dioxide.

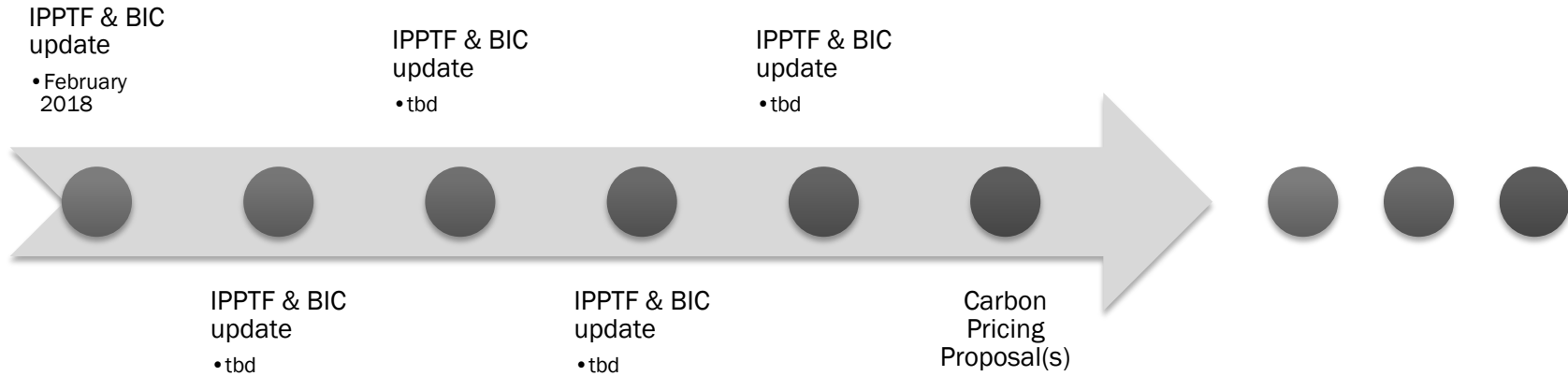

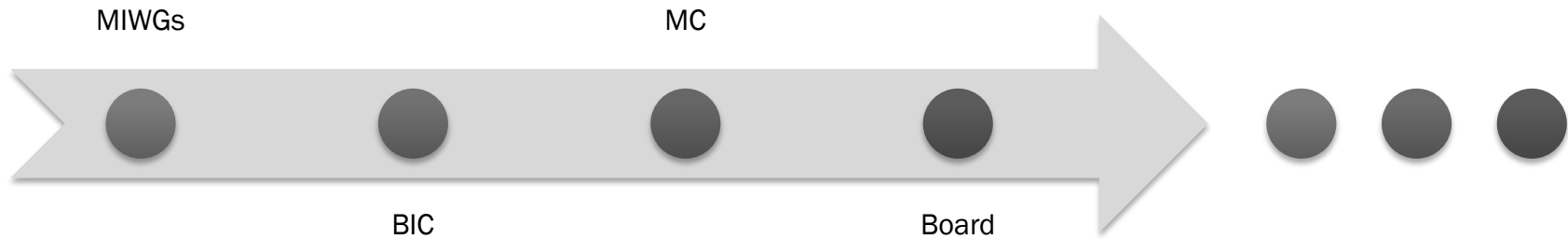
