NYISO Management Committee Meeting Minutes February 24, 2010 11:00 a.m. – 12:45 p.m.

1. Introductions, Meeting Objectives, and Chairman's Report

Mr. Glen McCartney (Constellation Energy), the Chair of the Management Committee (MC) called the meeting to order at 11:00 a.m. and welcomed the members of the MC. Meeting participants introduced themselves and their affiliations. A quorum was determined.

2. Approval of Meeting Minutes – December 22, 2009 and January 20, 2010

Motion #1:

Motion to approve the December 22, 2009 and the January 20, 2010 meeting minutes. The meeting minutes were approved unanimously.

3. President's Report

Mr. Steve Whitley (NYISO) presented the President's Report (see presentation). He provided an update on the DOE stimulus projects and the Eastern Interconnection Planning Collaborative.

Mr. Whitley reminded the group of the upcoming Committee Sector meetings scheduled to begin next week. To allow more time for Market Participants' lists of topics/concerns, the format has been revised from prior years; the NYISO will only present one topic and the remainder of the meeting will be devoted to the sector submitted topics.

Mr. Whitley also mentioned the Joint Board of Directors and Management Committee, to be held on June 14, 2010, and added that this meeting provides a great opportunity for interaction between Board members and Market Participants.

Ms. Echo Cartwright (NYISO) provided an update on the April 27 NYISO Symposium. This event will be held at the Desmond Hotel and will include three panel sessions: Broader Regional Markets, Carbon Constrained Economy, and Transmission Planning/Eastern Interconnection Planning Collaborative. Mr. Mark Spitzer, FERC Commissioner, has been confirmed as the keynote speaker. Mr. Whitley announced that Mr. Terry Boston and Mr. Gordon Van Wylie would be in attendance for the Broader Regional Markets panel.

Mary McGarvey provided an update on the FERC Metrics and stated that comments from Market Participants were due by March 5. The NYISO is working on capturing performance data on the metrics to ensure accuracy on comparisons. Mr. Whitely Steve informed that group that Chairman Wellinghoff had stated this was an important initiative.

Mr. Rich Dewey provided an update on the new facility. Mr. Howard Fromer (PSEG) asked if the budget has been changed; he suggested that any changes be included in the Management Committee monthly reports.

Mr. Rick Gonzales (NYISO) provided an update on uplift.

4. TCC Offers in Any Rounds

Mr. Chris Watts reported on TCC Offers in Any Round. The NYISO MMA provided the following statement:

The MMA was asked to provide an opinion about whether the proposed TCC rule change would make the TCC market more vulnerable to manipulation. Our opinion is that the proposed rule change would not adversely affect competition or raise substantial new manipulation concerns.

First, allowing firms with TCC holdings to sell into the auction does not provide them with a new means to affect the TCC clearing prices that doesn't already exist. Today, firms can have the same effect on the market by buying a counterflow TCC that offsets the TCC it already holds. The only effect from the proposed rule change is that the collateral requirements would recognize that the firm is not purchasing a new TCC, but rather, selling an existing one.

As a follow-up, Con Ed asked whether this change in the effective collateral requirement for such a transaction would provide firms with additional incentives or opportunities to manipulate prices. Manipulation is using one transaction that loses money to affect a clearing price for the purpose of benefiting the settlement of another transaction. Our opinion is that the current collateral requirements do not significantly inhibit manipulation because that is not their purpose. Rather, the two primary factors that would tend to inhibit or to discourage manipulation are that:

- (1) In a competitive/liquid market, other firms would respond to the manipulative transactions in a manner that would tend to undermine their effectiveness. This response will generally cause the losses incurred by the first transaction to be larger than the profits earned by the second transaction. Hence, it is important to design and operate a market that is liquid and competitive.
- (2) Existing monitoring and enforcement activities serve as a substantial deterrent to this conduct. Such a firm is subject to sizable penalties by FERC under its Anti-Manipulation Rule.

The NYISO monitors for manipulation in the TCC market by screening auction clearing prices against prices in other sub-auctions and DAM congestion prices. If anomalous price differentials between TCC prices or between TCC prices and DAM congestion prices are identified; the following is investigated:

- (1) These can be explained by changes in market information that became apparent after the anomalous prices were determined, and
- (2) There were bids that do not reflect reasonable expectations of congestion that also caused or contributed to the anomalous prices.

MMA was also requested to evaluate the proposed rule change. That review has occurred and our conclusions are consistent with what Potomac Economics just reported. NYISO did not identify any additional issues [introduced by this proposed change] beyond those

that are already present in the current market design. NYISO regularly reviews the TCC auction results and will continue to do so.

Responding to a question on if the NYISO would monitor the TCC market when these changes go in, it was explained the NYISO reviews the auction and given that is a new market feature will be looking at it.

Mr. Rich Miller (Con Edison) repeated his concern expressed at BIC. One lesson of loop flow – the burden should be put on the NYISO to make sure there weren't additional opportunities for market manipulation. It is necessary when new designs are being implemented to watch closer. NYISO should be considering with respect to MMU procedures any changes the need to be made to the TCC markets.

Mr. Howard Fromer (PSEG) mentioned that potentially more difficult issue to unravel in the event that we find a problem in one of the rounds that causes NYISO under current rules to negate offers in the Round.

Mr. Mark Younger requested that the pro's and cons on TCC settlements/shorter time for auction rounds be discussed at a future MIWG meeting.

Motion # 2

The Management Committee (MC) recommends that the Board of Directors approve for filing under Section 205 of the Federal Power Act, amendments to the Services Tariff and the OATT as proposed for the Offers in Any Round project pursuant to the presentation made at the February 24, 2010 MC meeting.

Mr. Paul Edmundson reported on Strategic Tariff Review Revenue Metering (see presentation).

Motion #3

The Management Committee (MC) recommends that the Board of Directors approve for filing under Section 205 of the Federal Power Act, amendments to the OATT and Market Services Tariff proposed as part of the Strategic Tariff Review for Revenue Metering, as described in the presentation made to the MC this date, February 24, 2010.

Motion passed unanimously.

6. Strategic Tariff Review: Demand Response

Mr. Dave Lawrence reported on Strategic Tariff Review – Demand Response (see presentation).

Motion #4

The Management Committee (MC) recommends that the Board of Directors approve for filing under Section 205 of the Federal Power Act, amendments to the Market Services Tariff proposed as part of the Strategic Tariff Review for Demand Response, as described in the presentation made to the MC this date, February 24, 2010.

Motion passed unanimously.
