


Summary of MP Programs

 Summary of MP Programs screen provides the following information specific to the MP organization





MP Enrollment in a Demand Response Program in DRIS


- MP organization must be Registered in the NYISO MIS as eligible to participate in the specific Demand Response program
 - Registered in the NYISO MIS = a "Qualified" MIS Status in DRIS
- MP organization must have an Admin Contact and an Event Responder Contact set up in DRIS for the specific Demand Response program
 - See training Part 5: Managing Organizational Contacts





MP Enrollment in a Demand Response Program in DRIS


- MP organization will automatically become Enrolled in DRIS for a specific DR program and Capability Period the first time they import a resource enrollment file for that <u>specific DR program and</u> <u>specific Capability Period</u>
 - MP organization may enroll at any time in the Capability Period based on the Resource Open Enrollment Event Calendar timeframe for the specific DR program
 - MP organization may be Qualified in MIS but not Enrolled in DRIS if no resource enrollment file was imported for that Capability Period – this will not affect future Capability Periods



MP SCR Program Details


- MP Performance Factor for the Capability Period

MP EDRP Program Details


- Select "EDRP" from the Program Search Criteria


