- Begin Deployment
- Due to the magnitude of changes, the deployment will require approximately 48 hours to perform.
- Please note, that during the deployment of the application unanticipated system conditions may cause the following schedule to be changed.



Deployment Schedule

August 11 - Continued

- The Daily File for Aug 10, 2003 should be uploaded to the FTP server by 11:00 a.m.
- NYISO will review Anomaly Report for the August 10th data and assuming that no significant issues are identified, NYISO will accelerate the running of the Daily Advisory for August 10.
- NYISO does not intend to issue an Anomaly report to the Meter Authorities on August 11.
- Following the issuance of the Daily Advisory for August 10, NYISO will begin the deployment of the Web-Based application.
- Daily Reconciliation & Invoices will experience a brief outage. Users may receive errors if trying to access these applications during the deployment period. Expected start time is 4:30 p.m. with a duration of 30 minutes.

- No Data will be submitted by Meter Authorities on August 12.
- A Daily Advisory will not be produced on August 12



Deployment Schedule

August 13

- The marketplace.nyiso.com and the Upload/Download templates in the MIS will be temporarily unavailable. Expected start time is 12:45 p.m. with an estimated duration of 30 minutes.
- The deployment of the Web-Based Application is expected to be completed by early afternoon.
- Upon completion, Customer Relations will notify Meter Authorities and request that data for August 11 and 12 be submitted via the Web-Based Reconciliation upload templates before 4:00 p.m.
- At 5:50 p.m. NYISO will initiate the job runs that will produce Daily Advisories for August 11 and 12. This job run is expected to run approximately 4 hours for each day's worth of data.
