# THE NEW YORK INDEPENDENT SYSTEM OPERATOR, INC. FINAL MINUTES OF BOARD OF DIRECTOR'S MEETING (VIA WEBEX) REGULAR SESSION – AUGUST 17, 2021

The Board of Directors of the New York Independent System Operator (NYISO) met, via WebEx, on August 17, 2021. Chairman Dan Hill chaired the meeting, and all Board members were present. Ms. Egan, Ms. Gach, Ms. Hussey, Ms. Nelson, and Messrs. Fernandez, Gonzales, Jones, Lanahan and Mukerji, were also present.

## I. Approval of Board Meeting Minutes

Upon motion duly made and seconded, the Board approved the June 15, 2021 Board meeting minutes, and deferred approval of the July 20, 2021 Board meeting minutes until the next meeting.

## II. Consent Agenda

Mr. Lynch made a motion for Board approval authorizing NYISO management to file, with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, pursuant to Section 205 of the Federal Power Act, the proposed revisions to the Services Tariff regarding the Metering & Meter Data Services Requirements for Demand Side Resources. The Board approved the motion.

## A. Audit & Compliance

- 2. Right-of-First-Refusal (ROFR) Ms. Gach briefed the R&M Committee on the ROFR issue. The NYISO proposal was presented to the Business Issues Committee (BIC) on August 11, 2021 and passed, and will now be presented to the Management Committee on August 25, 2021. The NYISO proposal will be brought back to the Reliability & Markets Committee for discussion and approval in September.
- 3. Buyer-Side Mitigation(BSM)—Comprehensive Mitigation Reform Update NYISO management provided a summary of the PJM MOPR filing at FERC. Mr. Lynch and Mr. Dan Hill will follow up with staff on the PJM MOPR.
- 4. Mr. Smith reported that the NYISO sent out to the Long Island Export Public Policy Transmission Need Solicitation letter to the stakeholders on August 12, 2021. Comments are due back on October 11, 2021.
