- On Friday April 9, 2021 the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission issued an order accepting NYISO Economic Planning tariff revisions, effective April 11, 2021, as filed with no changes
  - Docket# ER21-1074-000

- NYISO will now begin revisions to the Economic Planning Manual to reflect tariff revisions
- System & Resource Outlook will kickoff following manual revisions
- Draft manual revisions and preliminary study schedule to be provided at May 20<sup>th</sup> ESPWG meeting
