

### What we heard


- Concerns with CLCPA implementation

## **June Joint Board Meeting**

### Our takeaways

- We need to create a broader 2022 public affairs outreach campaign
  - How we communicate and distribute content needs to shift
- We need to create a "sharper" 2022 campaign
  - The content we build needs to be sharply themed on reliability
- We've done a good job so far with target audiences (lawmakers, policymakers, media, opinion leaders) but not as good communicating to MPs
