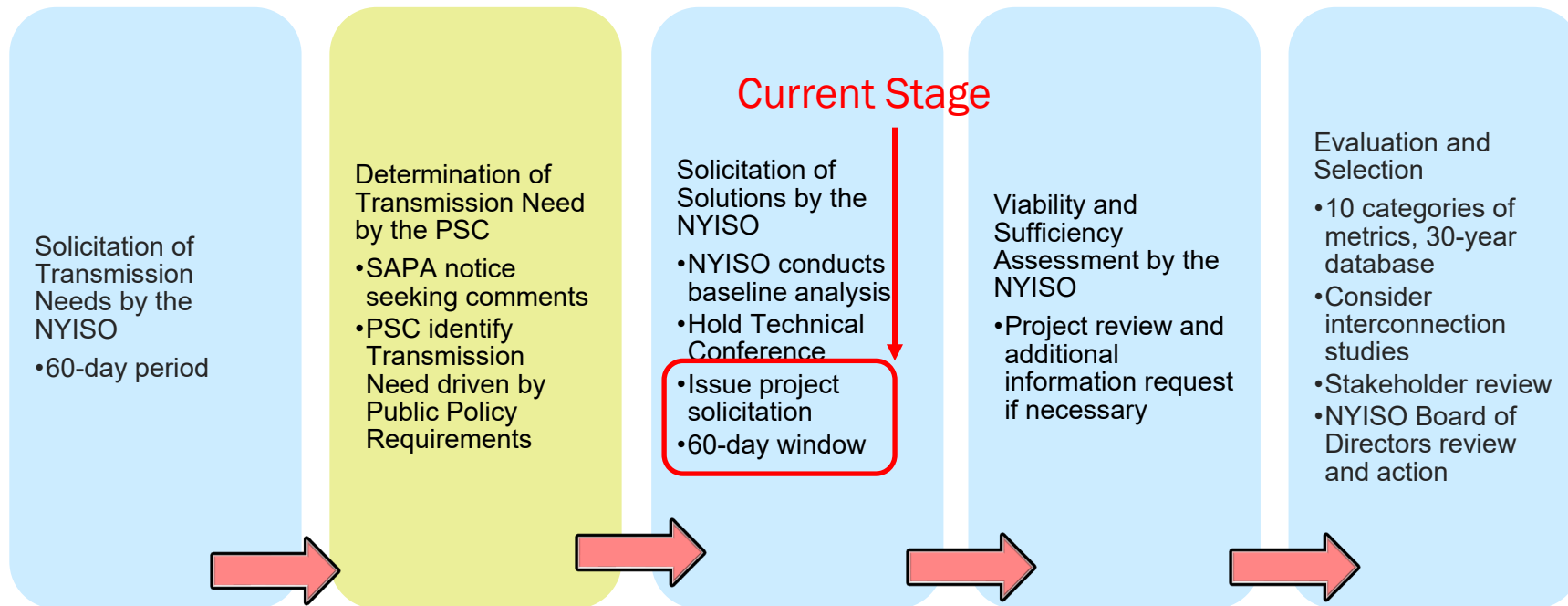

# Solicitation for PPTN Projects

- PPTP projects and interconnection application due by 11:59 pm EST on October 11, 2021
- Solicitation materials are posted on <https://www.nyiso.com/cspp> -> Public Policy Documents -> Long Island Offshore Wind Export PPTN
  - PPTN Solicitation
  - 3 FAQ documents
  - Baseline assessment results and Technical Conference presentation
- Developers must submit a separate application for each Public Policy Transmission Project and Other Public Policy Project.

# Public Policy Project Submissions

- **Public Policy Transmission Projects and Other Public Policy Projects must be emailed to [PublicPolicyPlanningMailbox@nyiso.com](mailto:PublicPolicyPlanningMailbox@nyiso.com)**
- **Developers may upload complete application packages to a NYISO box.com folder.**
  - Email [PublicPolicyPlanningMailbox@nyiso.com](mailto:PublicPolicyPlanningMailbox@nyiso.com) with name of Developer and list of individuals' emails who will upload files by October 7<sup>th</sup>
  - Send an email to [PublicPolicyPlanningMailbox@nyiso.com](mailto:PublicPolicyPlanningMailbox@nyiso.com) referencing which files were uploaded to the box.com folder

# Interconnection Applications

- **Transmission Interconnection Application (or Large Facility Interconnection Request) must be submitted through the Interconnection Projects Portal, <https://nyiso.force.com/Interconnection/s/login/>**
  - Developers without a portal account should request one by October 6<sup>th</sup>
- **Email [nyisofinanceplanningstudies@nyiso.com](mailto:nyisofinanceplanningstudies@nyiso.com) for instructions on submitting application fees and study deposits**
  - When making payment, indicate what project[s] and application fees/deposits the payment is for
  - For each project, a \$10k Public Policy application fee and \$100k Public Policy study deposit are due at time of application. In addition, a \$10k interconnection application fee is due with the submission of a Transmission Interconnection Application and the study deposit will be due at a later stage.
