Background



Background

- The NYISO filed tariff revisions on September 13, 2021 to modify the types of entities eligible to provide metering and/or meter data services.
 - The updated revisions explicitly allow municipal electric utilities to provide metering and/or meter data services for Demand Side Resources.
 - On November 10, 2021 the FERC issued an Order accepting the tariff changes, effective November 13, 2021, as requested.



Summary of Changes – Revenue Metering Requirements Manual (RM²) (Manual 25)

 Section 1.2 - Expansion of the terminology/definition for Meter Authority to include municipal electric utilities.
