## Re: Verified Report of Credit Facility Costs and Expenses Case 18-E-0439 – Petition of The New York Independent System Operator, Inc. for Authority to Incur Indebtedness for a Term in Excess of Twelve Months

Dear Secretary Phillips:

In compliance with Ordering Clause No. 6 of the order issued by the New York State Public Service Commission ("Commission") on November 16, 2018 in the above-captioned proceeding ("November 16 Order"),<sup>1 2</sup> the New York Independent System Operator, Inc. ("NYISO") hereby submits this verified report regarding the costs and expenses associated with the credit facilities authorized by the November 16 Order:

 The NYISO amended the credit facilities authorized in Ordering Clause Nos. 2<sup>3</sup> and 3<sup>4</sup> of the November 16 Order to replace the London Interbank Offered Rate ("LIBOR"), which was used to calculate the applicable interest rate for those credit facilities, with an equivalent rate calculated based on the Secured Overnight Financing Rate ("SOFR"). This amendment was necessary because LIBOR will fully expire in 2023 and will no longer be available for calculating interest rates.
