

Subject: Demand Side Ancillary Services Program Registration Deadline

Statement: This Technical Bulletin provides the deadline to submit DSASP Registration Packets.

Consistent with market rules accepted by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“Commission”) on January 23, 2020 in Docket No. ER19-2276, the NYISO will retire the Demand Side Ancillary Services Program (“DSASP”) when DSASP Resources become eligible to utilize the Distributed Energy Resource (“DER”) and Aggregation market rules. In preparation for the retirement of the DSASP, the NYISO will stop accepting DSASP Resource applications at 5:00 PM on May 2, 2022.¹

Completed DSASP Registration Packets submitted by May 2 will be processed in accordance with the existing DSASP registration processes. Incomplete DSASP registration packets submitted before the deadline will be processed on a best-efforts basis.

Direct Communications for DSASP Resources

Ancillary Services Manual Section 6.2.3.9 permits up to 200 MW of DSASP Resource capability to directly communicate with the NYISO Control Center. As of the date of this Technical Bulletin [xxx], the entire 200 MW has been allocated to DSASP Resources. If a Resource utilizing direct communications exits the DSASP prior to May 2, 2022, the Resource’s MW value will be made available to other DSASP Resources. If a Resource exits the DSASP after May 2, 2022, those MW will not be made available to new or existing DSASP Resources.

This Technical Bulletin is not currently expected to be incorporated into a NYISO Manual/User Guide.

¹ The NYISO will reevaluate this deadline if the DER participation model implementation date is delayed.
