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Automated ICAP Import Rights - Overview



- For implementation beginning with the Summer 2019 Capability Period, the ICAP "First-Come, First-Served" Imports Rights processes will be automated
 - Replaces the "race to the fax", among other processes, for the Summer 2019 Capability Period, which will begin in March 2019
 - Create, edit, prioritize, and submit FCFS Import Right Requests
 - Replaces the provision of supporting bilateral contracts with an automated bilateral confirmation process within the ICAP AMS
 - "Seller" (ICAP Suppliers) and " buyer " (LSEs and ICAP Marketers that are not an Affiliate of the seller) confirmation of Import Rights
 - Replaces the manual Import Rights Returns process currently performed by NYISO staff with an automated return process within the ICAP AMS

Creating Multiple Import Right Requests Within One FCFS Request Form



- Seller can create multiple FCFS Import Right Requests for one or more months of the selected Capability Period within one Import Right Request Form
- Seller can submit multiple Import Right Requests for a single request and allocation period
- All the requests within one Import Right Requests Form will have the same submission order according to submission time
- Within the form, the individual FCFS Import Right Requests will have a relative priority established by how the seller has arranged them, as described in previous slide

Buyer Confirmation Process – FCFS Import Right Requests



- The buyer confirmation period is the business day following the date the FCFS request period for the seller closes
- Identified by the ICAP Event Calendar
- Buyers, counterparty to sellers of submitted FCFS Import Right Requests, must confirm their Import Right Requests in the ICAP AMS before the confirmation period closes
- Submitted FCFS Import Right Requests that are not buyer confirmed at the close of the buyer confirmation period will be automatically rejected

Seller Obligations during Monthly Certification

- For every month that a seller has been awarded a FCFS Import Right, Seller must
 - Confirm the FCFS Import Right bilateral in the ICAP AMS
 - Process described in the next slide
 - Provide a corresponding MIS-Transaction ID
 - Existing procedure described in the ICAP manual
- Performed during the obligation month's Certification period
 - Dates/times of Certification period open/close specified in ICAP event calendar

FCFS Import Rights – Returns Process



- Awarded FCFS Import Rights may be returned on Non-Fully Allocated and Fully Allocated Interfaces according to specific deadlines
 - In the Import Rights module of the ICAP AMS
 - Both Buyer and Seller perform tasks for the Returns process
- For Non-Fully Allocated Interfaces, the FCFS Import Right may be reduced in 0.1 MW increments or completely returned
- For Non-Fully Allocated Interfaces, the Return Deadline is up to when the Certification Period for the Obligation month closes



FCFS Import Rights- Returns Process, cont.

- For Fully Allocated Interfaces, the FCFS Import Right must be completely returned
- For Fully Allocated Interfaces, the Return Deadline is based on when the External Interface becomes fully allocated
 - Before the Certification Period of obligation month
 - Before the begin time of the Certification Period for the obligation month of the FCFS Import Right award
 - During Certification period of obligation month
 - 5:00 p.m. ET on the business day following the notice of a Fully Allocated Interface
