# Background

- **On February 17, 2022 FERC issued an Order on Rehearing that reversed its previous order and accepted the NYISO's April 30, 2020 proposed revisions to the Part A Test found in 23.4.5.7 of Attachment H of the Services Tariff (BSM Rules).**
  - The order specified that the proposed effective date should be no later than the start of the next Class Year
- **On March 21, 2022 the NYISO submitted a compliance filing to comply with the directives in the February 2022 Order**
  - The NYISO proposed to make the Part A enhancement effective date for the Class Year immediately following Class Year 2021
  - The NYISO also requested an extension of time to of August 1, 2022 to submit required conforming tariff language
- **On June 2, 2022 FERC issued an Order that requires the NYISO to submit a further compliance filing no later than August 1, 2022 that includes a specific effective date for the Part A enhancements as well as any necessary tariff revisions necessary to make the Part A enhancements effective for the next Class Year**

# MST 23.2.1 Definitions

- Replaced references to “Class Year 2019” with “Class Year immediately following Class Year 2021”
- Replaced effective date of July 1, 2020 with August 1, 2022
- Revised Public Policy Resource definition to remove redundancy with Excluded Facility definition by making the following change:
  - “Public Policy Resource” shall mean for purposes of Section 23.4.5 of this Attachment H, an Examined Facility ~~that is an Energy Storage Resource, or an Intermittent Power Resource solely powered by wind or solar energy, or~~ that is determined by the ISO to be a zero-emitting resource and ~~that does not meet the definition of Excluded Facility and has not been deemed a Excluded Facility by the NYISO.~~
- Removed Unforced Reserve Margin definition as this was only used in Renewable Exemption
- Removed Incremental Regulatory Retirement def definition as this was only used in Renewable Exemption

# MST 23.4.5.7.2, 23.4.5.7.3, and 23.4.5.7.15

- Replaced references to Class Year 2019 with **Class Year 2023** the Class Year immediately following Class Year 2021
- Replaced effective date of July 1, 2020 with August 1, 2022
- **23.4.5.7.3.1**
  - Removed references to the Renewable Exemption
- **23.4.5.7.3.1.2**
  - Removed references to the Renewable Exemption
- **23.4.5.7.3.1.3**
  - Removed reference to “solar photovoltaic and battery” that irrelevant in this section due to CMR Order
- **23.4.5.7.3.1.4**
  - Removed Class Year 2019 effective date reference
- **23.4.5.7.15.5.2**
  - Removed references to Renewable Exemption
