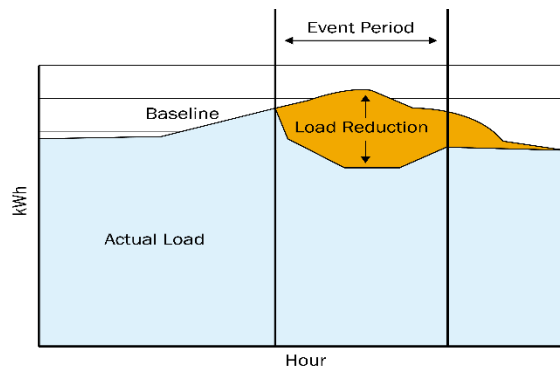


Emergency Demand Response Program

The **Emergency Demand Response Program (EDRP)** allows market participants to provide load reduction

- Min **100kW** reduction in single Load Zone
- Response is **voluntary** during grid emergencies or when reserve shortages are anticipated or actually occur

Response Type C:

Curtailment: Curtailing the resource facility's load



Response Type G:

Generation: Use of a qualified behind-the-meter local generator

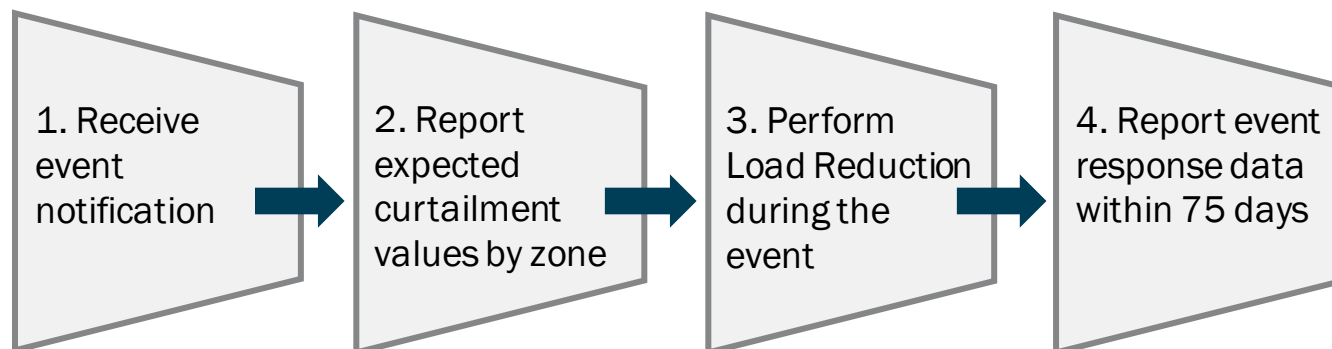


Response Type B:
