## **Enterprise Cost Management (ECM)**

#### What is it?

 Program designed to provide NYISO with a better understanding of how costs are allocated, and resources are used in regard to supporting the NYISO's discrete products and services

#### Goal?

Enhance NYISO decision-making capability and cost management

#### Components?

 Evolving current business model for cost tracking through activity-based costing, time reporting and resource allocation



#### **Benefits of ECM**

- Identify and provide transparency to cost of routine business activities (Activity Based Costing)
- Enhance effectiveness of annual planning and budgeting process
- Better respond to dynamic, changing priorities
- Identify and manage risk related to stakeholder commitments and day-to-day departmental operations
- Identify resource needs for better workforce planning
