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# Overview of the Manual Changes

- **Current DADRP Manual is being refreshed and updated as described**
- **Incorporated changes due to FERC Order No. 745 compliance**
  - Monthly Net Benefits Test Offer Price
  - Economic Customer Baseline (“ECBL”)
  - Cost allocation changes
- **Incorporated Technical Bulletin 237 into the DADRP Manual**
  - Originally issued on 7/27/2016 and describes the Local Generator Requirements in DADRP
- **Incorporated the DADRP Registration Packets Updates**
- **Overall refresh, removed obsolete language and replaced redundant language with relevant Tariff and Manual references**

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# Summary of Updates

## Section 1. Definitions and Acronyms

- Replaced definitions that already exist in the Tariff with relevant Tariff References
- Added subsection 1.2 for definitions that do not exist in the Tariff

## Section 2. Day-Ahead Demand Response Program – Introduction

- Removed redundant language by transferring the following subsections to relevant sections in the Manual
  - 2.2, 2.3, 2.4, 2.5, 2.6, 2.7, 2.8, 2.9, 2.10, 2.11, 2.12, 2.13, 2.16
- Removed obsolete subsections 2.14 and 2.15
- Added references to NYISO Tariffs, Accounting & Billing Manual, Market Participant User's Guide

- Added references to the DADRP Provider Registration Packet and DADRP Resource Registration Packet
- Replaced redundant language with tariff references in subsection 3.4

- Replaced screenshots in subsections 4.1 and 4.2 with references to Market Participant User's Guide
- Added subsections 4.3 and 4.4

- Incorporated Local Generator Requirements from TB-237 into subsections 5.1 and 5.3
- Added content and tariff references to ECBL to subsections 5.2 and 5.3
- Replaced redundant language and added tariff references to subsections 5.4 and 5.5.
